Directions to the Pomfret Townhouse



From the west, take Route 44 East into Pomfret. Turn left to follow Route 44 at the intersection by the Putnam Bank. Town House Drive will be on your left.

From the North. Follow Route 169. After the Vanilla Bean, Route 44 and 169 are joined. Where they split, stay left on Route 44. Townhouse Drive will be on your right.

From the east, follow Route 101 into Pomfret. After the traffic light by the Loos Co, stay on route 101 until you come to Route 44. Turn right onto Route 44. Town House Drive will be on your left.
